Nicky Barnetson, Partnership Development Manager of Refugee Resource in Oxford is coming to speak at the **10 am Service in St Mary's on Sunday 17 February**. We held a special collection for this charity at Christmas. In her letter of thanks, Nicky writes:

“It is so difficult for refugees when they get to the UK, after suffering ordeals in the country they came from and/or on the journey here. Many who are referred to us have suffered multiple traumas including conflict, loss/separation from loved ones, violence and exploitation”. During the last year Refugee Resource helped over 300 clients from across 36 nationalities. We look forward to welcoming Nicky and learning more about Refugee Resource and the needs of refugees in Oxfordshire.

Wallingford Parish Electoral Roll 2019

Under Church of England regulations we are required to completely renew the Parish Electoral Roll every six years and 2019 is the appropriate anniversary. Notice of this process must be given two months before the Annual Parochial Church Meeting which takes place this year on 7th April. A letter addressed to every current member of the Electoral Roll, containing an explanatory letter and new application forms, can be found at the back of the church today and for the next two Sundays. For those not currently registered as a member of the Roll there are spare copies of all the documentation. Please collect these as you leave church today.

Forms must be returned to us not later than March 10th to enable the new Roll to be published and displayed in church on Sunday March 17th and for at least 14 days thereafter (Names only will be displayed in church, not any additional personal information).
