Team Vicar Vacancy - Next Steps

The team from across the Benefice has been working on the team profile, role description and person specification, and these are now complete. We have two important meetings booked, and the dates for the advertising of the post and interview of the candidate(s) have also been scheduled:

Section 11 Meeting - Wed 7 Jan 2026. This is a joint meeting of the three PCCs in the Benefice; its main purposes are to agree the team profile, role description and person specification, and to appoint two members of each PCC to represent the interests of their parish at the shortlisting meeting and on the appointment panel. How to advertise the post will also be agreed.

Section 12 Meeting - Thurs 22 Jan 2026. This meeting will be led by Archdeacon David Tyler. Again, this is a joint meeting of the three PCCs in the benefice. Its purpose is to set the scene for all that follows in the appointment process and will include discussion and agreement on a final team profile etc, agree the advertisement and the following dates:

- * the role will be advertised from Friday 20th February until Sunday 22nd March,
- * a shortlisting meeting will be held on Tuesday, 24th March,
- * the interview(s) will be held on Thursday 16th of April.

Associate Archdeacon Jane Haslam and Bishop Gavin will lead these two steps.
