The Faculty notice will be complete soon and is expected to be granted by the Diocesan Chancellor as we have been busy complying with all the stipulations of the DAC, including a Written Scheme of Investigation for the archaeology work for the new drainage channels in the churchyard. From the two tenders received so far, we are budgeting for £150k.



The "Daily Office"

Did you know that the Church of England provides a free app called Daily Prayer which means that everyone can share in the Morning and Evening Prayer each day, wherever they are? Just search for it in your app store and it will look like the blue icon. It provides all the daily readings, psalms and prayers on screen, so that there are no pages to find. You can even switch between the modern "Common Worship" or the traditional "Book of Common Prayer" versions. Although the role of clergy is to pray "vicariously" on behalf of the whole village, all church members are encouraged to join in, not least if you are free to join us on Friday mornings and Sunday evenings.

Pilgrimage Walk along St Frideswide's Way

This summer sees the inaugural pilgrimage along St Frideswide's Way, which follows the Thames between Oxford and Reading. The pilgrimage walk begins in Oxford on 26th June and ends in Reading on 29th June. You could choose to do the whole walk or just one day.
