• Refurbishment - Loo & Servery – There has been much work done over the past month, the new floor for the Servery has been laid, the back pew on the North Aisle has been removed and the floor levelled and retiled, and all the structural woodwork is almost complete. There are now signs of a Loo and Servery shaped spaces visible. The new Pew Ends are almost ready, so work to replace the Pews will be happening very soon. We were hoping to be able to use the Church for Christmas, and the Builders would have helped us to move the endless bits and bobs, but there would be so much work to do to make it usable, that we felt we would not be up to the challenge so near to the Christmas Season.

We are hoping that we shall have a Faculty granted very soon for a new floor in the Lady Chapel (North Aisle) and also for the floor to be raised in the old Kitchen.
