The "Daily Office"

Did you know that the Church of England provides a free app called Daily Prayer which means that everyone can share in the Morning and Evening Prayer each day, wherever they are? Just search for it in your app store and it will look like the blue icon. It provides all the daily readings, psalms and prayers on screen, so that there are no pages to find. You can even switch between the modern "Common Worship" or the traditional "Book of Common Prayer" versions. Although the role of clergy is to pray "vicariously" on behalf of the whole village, all church members are encouraged to join in, not least if you are free to join us on Wednesday mornings.
